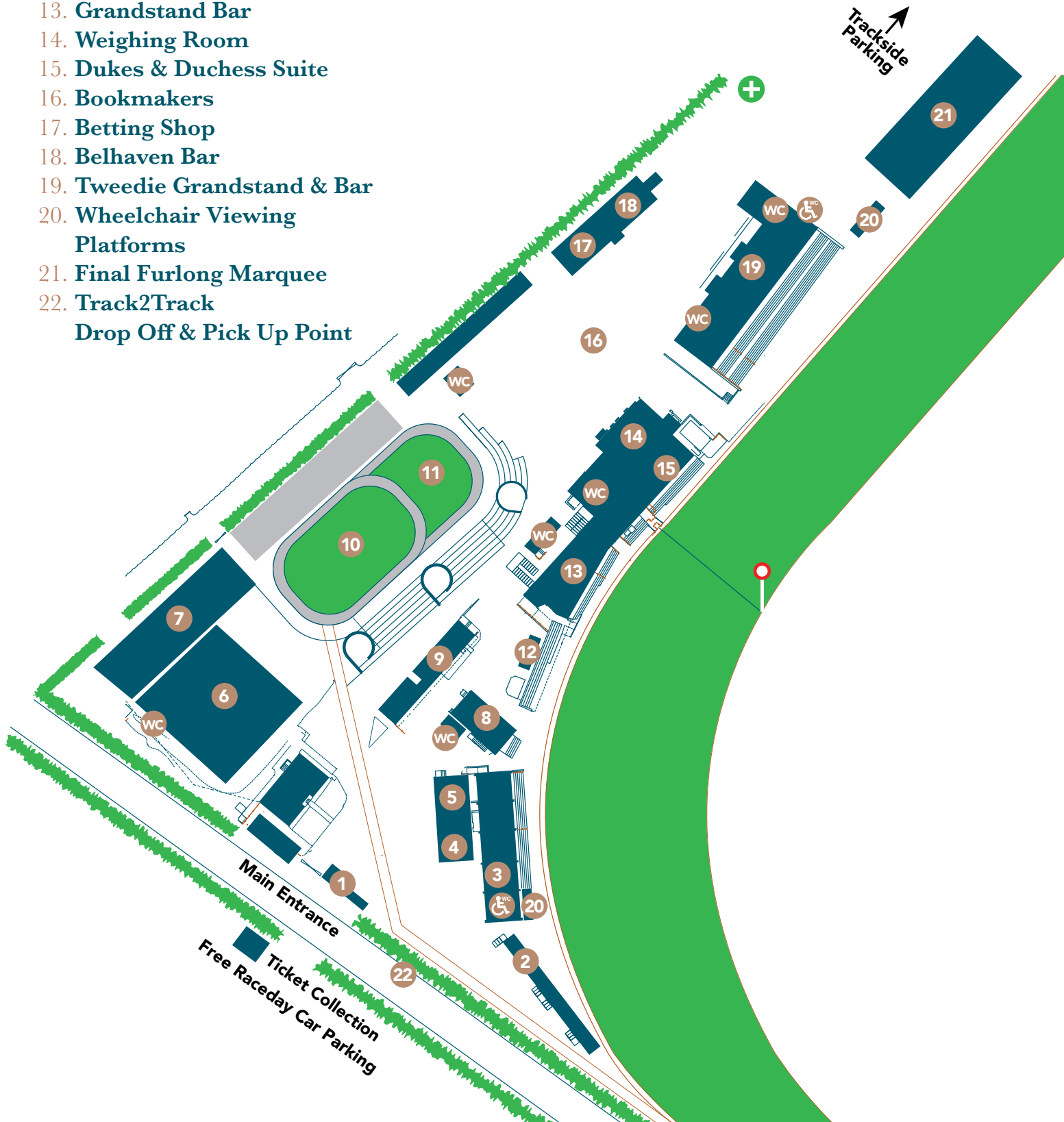

All you need to know

Tickets

Please bring your tickets along with you on the day. Should you decide to exit the racecourse during racing and wish to come back, please ensure that you 'scan out' to ensure that your ticket is valid for re-entry.

Location

The Racecourse can be found one mile north of Kelso Town centre, in the beautiful Scottish Borders Countryside.

Parking

There is free parking in the field adjacent to the main entrance. Trackside Parking is also available at an additional cost, and must be booked in advance. Cars may be left overnight, however this is done so at the owners risk.

Public Transport

The Borders Railway provides opportunities for travel, directly from Edinburgh to Tweedbank. Our Track2Track service gives you return bus transfer from Tweedbank station to the Racecourse for only £12pp - Please note this must be booked in advance & has limited spaces. If you are coming from the South the nearest station is Berwick-on-Tweed and is 22 miles from the course where public bus or Taxi would then be required.

Dress Code

Not everyone wears tweed at Kelso - the norm is "smart casual". For a lot of racegoers (especially on Ladies Day) dressing up is all part of the fun of going racing and we always advise dressing for the very unpredictable Scottish weather!

Accessibility

We are in the process of improving accessibility for all customers around the racecourse. We have two wheelchair platforms with track viewing & disabled toilets located close by. There are also 3 mobility scooters available to book in advance & free of charge. Please contact us with any other queries, we are more than happy to assist.

Betting

Tote betting is available throughout the course with a winning dividend declared after each race, tote profits are used to support horseracing. Independent Bookmakers, located outside the Tweedie Grandstand, offer fixed odds betting, which means if you place a £1 Win bet on a horse marked on their board at 8/1 you will receive £9 (£8, plus your original £1 bet) if the horse wins.

Food & Drink

There are several food outlets including the Kelsae Yorkie Bar, Tweedie Stand Café, Rosie's Bistro & Feelin' Peckish burger van. While picnics may be consumed in the 'Trackside Parking' area approximately one furlong from the winning post, racegoers are not permitted to bring their own food or drink in to public enclosures.
